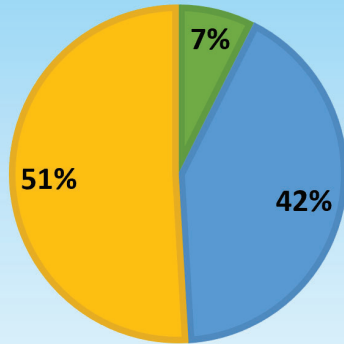

Falcon Support Time

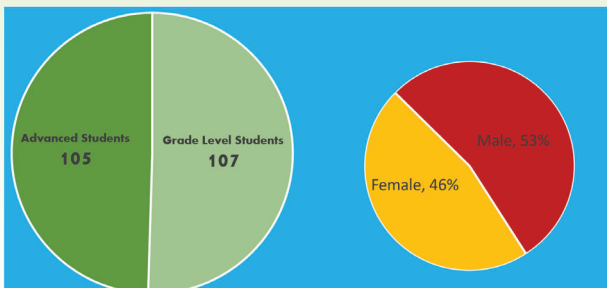
Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday's from 7:30-8:00 am and 3:15-3:45 PM

#Self Aware

Counseling Advisory Lessons this year were on self awareness in 4 areas: **Conflict Resolution, Healthy Relationships, Coping Skills, Self Esteem**

95% of people think they are self aware, while only 10-15% actually are!

Learn about yourself:

- My strengths, core values, passions, interests, and personality

Practice some form of self-reflection:

- Meditate or pray, write about your feelings, talk to others, listen; really listen to feedback

Set goals:

- Know what you want and where you want to go

Understand others:

- Seek to understand others, be sensitive to others feelings, understand myself in relation to others, practice active listening; not debating, defending, counter-attacking

Manage emotions and actions:

- How do I handle stress, manage anger, moods, time, and take care of my mind and body

Enhance self-management:

- Be aware of emotional flooding and faulty thinking: the moment your emotions trump your ability to think.

Display empathy toward others:

- How well do I display understanding towards others, express my feelings, be positive

Deal with difficult situations:

- How well do I actively listen to the other person, lead others, manage relationships, knowing it's not always about me
